### On the day

When you arrive at P&J Live, please make your way to the first floor (upper concourse) where the registration desk will be located and where you will receive your badge. **Please ensure you let the EGC1 team know you are a poster presenter.** All posters will be displayed in **Conference Suite 1**.

Registration on day 1 is open from 8AM. Posters should preferably be set up from 8AM on Day 1, at the latest by 08:45AM on Day 1. Posters should stay up on the poster boards throughout the entire 3-day conference, to allow those not attending the entire 3 days to view all of the posters presented.

Posters will be grouped by topic (e.g., Exploration in the Energy Transition, Geoscience in CCUS etc.). Once you have registered, the poster conveners will be around to assist you in setting up your poster in the correct location and to answer any questions.

Suggested poster viewing sessions will be added to the programme and will compliment/reflect the oral presentation topics occurring on the same day. You will be expected to be at your poster during the breaks on that day. During other days where your poster topic group is not a suggested poster viewing, we recommend that you add a note to your poster board telling conference attendees when you may be available for discussions and questions at your poster.

### Poster Specifications

- Each presenter will have two poster board panels, and these will be laid out in a chevron layout therefore we do not recommend landscape format posters; portrait format (one per panel) will work best.
- **Maximum dimensions of 841mm width by 1189 height for each A0 portrait**
- Velcro will be provided to attach your poster to the board.
- Printing: you are responsible for printing your own poster and delivering/ bringing it to the venue on the day of the event.
- Storage space will be provided for you to store your poster-case we will show you where this is when you arrive.
- Posters can only be dismantled after the last refreshment break which ends at 16:00 on 18 May, however, please inform a member of the events team if you need to take your poster down before then.
