- Please have your presentation open and ready for your talk. If you do use the desktop then for confidentiality please make sure all emails and notifications are turned off and there is nothing on your desktop you would not want to share with the audience
- The session chairs will be monitoring the Q&A for any questions relating to your talk. They will then read out the questions for you to answer. Please remember to speak directly into your microphone.
